



SHEPPERTON MARINA WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

Who is responsible for the waste on-site?

Shepperton Marina Ltd provide and is responsible for the disposal of waste on site but it is up to the user to segregate the waste properly and ensure the waste is disposed of correctly in the bins provided.

What are the Marina's objectives?

Shepperton Marina's aim is to reduce the amount of waste generated on-site and to ensure all waste is disposed of in the correct manner, and we recycle as much as we can. This can be achieved through providing the correct bins and educating our customers through signage and information boards.

Waste types that can be disposed of / recycled at the Marina

- Paper
- Metal
- Glass
- Clothes
- Waste oil
- Plastic
- WEEE (electrical items)
- Card board
- General waste
- Hazardous waste

Shepperton Marina Ltd recycle between 50% - 75% of its overall waste and our target is to bring that figure up to 75% or higher.

Waste & Recycling bins located onsite

Mixed Recycling Bins

Paper, glass bottles, tin cans, aerosols and food containers can be placed into the mixed recycling bins which is then collected by Spelthorne borough council every two weeks.

Compactor

Flat packed card board & plastic sheeting can be compacted (separately) and bailed which is then collected by an outside contractor.

Clothes Bin

Clothes can be recycled on-site by placing them into the 'clothes bin' located in the main carpark. This is then collected by Spelthorne borough council and donated to charity.

Mixed Metal Bin

There is a metal bin located on-site for the recycling of mixed metals. Information of how to dispose of metal though Shepperton Marina can be found inside the Marina office.

WEEE Bin (electrical items)

Only WEEE items produced by Shepperton Marina Ltd can be disposed of on-site which is then collected by City Electrical Factors Ltd (CEF). It is the responsibility of all other offices and bertholders to dispose of WEEE items responsibly off-site.

General Waste

General waste is to go in the general waste bins only, this is then collected by Veolia once a week, every Thursday morning.

Hazardous waste

Used Paint Cans

Used paint cans can be disposed of by placing them in the hazardous waste bin located in the recycling point. Due to it being hazardous waste this bin is kept locked and the key can be obtained from the marina office.

Waste Oil

Waste oil can be disposed of in the Main car park at Shepperton Marina. The waste oil bin is kept locked for environmental management purposes and the key can be issued to berthholders & tenants only.
